Please call the school office if you are unable to make this booking online and we can do this for you.

Covid-19 Level 1 - It is now looking quite likely that we will be moving to Level 1 very soon. We will keep you updated with information once we have this confirmed and what this will mean for our school and your child/ren.

Cohort Entry for New Entrants commences at the beginning of Term 3. This means that all children turning five this term will start on their birthdays. Next Term there will be two entry dates for five year olds - Tm 3, 20/7 & 17/8 Tm 4 12/10, 16/11. We will send more information on this later in the term.

Important information from Te Taiwhenua o Heretaunga and Hawke's Bay DHB Say Ahh Teams

Under COVID-19 it is very important that any child who presents with a sore throat, runny nose, cough, high temperature and/or temporary loss of smell, **stays at home**.

Please seek advice from a nurse or doctor if your child has any of these symptoms. You can phone **Healthline o8003585453 or your doctor** following the Ministry of Health's advice.

Under Covid-19 there will be no **throat swabbing in schools**.

It is very important that children with sore throats be tested for both COVID-19 and Strep throat and should be referred to your doctor.

Please follow the advice received from your nurse or **doctor** if you have been given antibiotics. These must be taken for the full 10 days – even if they start to feel better.
